'Don't measure your life by your ability; measure it by God's' READ Joshua 1:1-6

1. Joshua and the people were facing some very real and legitimate obstacles, which could have caused fear to creep into their hearts and

kept them in the wilderness instead of entering the land of God's promise. How could the following have stopped them in their tracks

Moses' death

The logistics of the task

The hostile nations already there

The uncertainty of a new, uncharted homeland

- 2. Think about a time you faced deep loss, fear or a sense that the road ahead of you was too hard to travel in the strength you had. Can you see how God drew near, gave you strength and helped you move forward?
- **3.** Think about challenges facing you in the future, can you imagine that God is leading you? How can your fellow disciples here in this group encourage you to press forward into God's inheritance?
- 4. Read Joshua 1:7-9. What did God say to Joshua to empower him to press boldly outward? How can these words also uplift and inspire you to move forward into God's inheritance?
- **5.** Can scripture help to keep us moving forward? How can we harness the truth of God's word and promises?

There is a clip in the video that described an undeserved gift. If you have experienced anything like this, it may be helpful in relating that experience to God's grace and the inheritance he has for you.

- 6. Read Joshua 1:3-4, 24:28 and Ephesians 1:3. Why is it so important for us to understand that our inheritance from God is a *gift* and not something that we have *earned*.
- 7. Read John 1:12-13, Romans 8:14-17, 2Cor 5:16-18 & Heb 13:20-21
 What is God promising to give as a spiritual inheritance to his children?
 How are you already experiencing some of these blessings?
