Our group will seek to make itself a safe place: we will try to make each other feel loved and valued and be trustworthy when we share about ourselves.

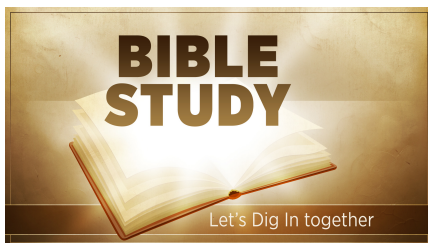
We want to keep growing in love and understanding of The Lord and give permission to others in the group to help us in our journey.

Matthew 22 The greatest commandment

34 Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. **35** One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: **36** 'Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?' **37** Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind." [c] **38** This is the first and greatest commandment. **39** And the second is like it: "Love your neighbour as yourself." [d] **40** All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.'

Questions

1. If you gave a knee jerk answer to verse 36 what would you say? Jesus says that loving God and loving our Neighbours should be our two top goals. Why these and not others?
2. Love is an abstract idea. On a practical level, how does a person go about loving God?
3. Share some examples of how people you know have loved a neighbour well. What does love look like in action?
4. Is it possible to love God without loving our Neighbours? Explain your reasoning.
5. What do you think happens when someone tries to love others without loving God?

Not long after this incident with the Pharisees, Jesus knew he was about to be arrested and killed. He gave his followers another command to add to the first two:

34 'A new command I give you: love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. **35** By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.' **John 13**

6. How is this command like the two earlier ones?

How is it different?

7. What is your reaction to the idea that the Christian life boils down to relationships- Love for God and Love for others?
8. In what situation this week will it be challenging for you to Love God or others?

Loving God and others can't really be separated. Life together with God means life together with others and vice versa.
